 - ▶ **This assessment was administered via telepractice. X was used as the normative measure, and initial evidence for the equivalence of scores with face-to-face administration has been established by early studies (and cite those)**

Telepractice Research Links

- ▶ [Peter et al.](#) studied a preventative intervention they coined “Babble Boot Camp.”
- ▶ Results from Skype Me! Sarah Roseberry et al suggested that the toddlers were only able to learn novel words from video chats and live interaction (not TV)
- ▶ [Douglas et al.](#), sheds some light on effective parent training and coaching online. watching videos on various modules on their own time parents increased their communication opportunities and responses to child’s communication. Children also showed increased communicative attempts.
